

Auctav Yearling Sale

A fifth wild card and leading sires represented

This Saturday, 13 September, Flat yearlings will go under the hammer at Auctav with Yoshino, the fifth wild card of the catalogue, among a line-up that features the progeny of leading sires making current headlines.

Leading sires in the spotlight

Wynola (Lot 98) stands out as a daughter of Aga Khan's incomparable sire **Siyouni**, from the outstanding Turtle Bowl family. Her second dam, when crossed with Siyouni, has already produced two black-type performers – *Ellersile Lace* and *Baha Mar*.

Another stallion riding high in the rankings is **Goken**, who leads the way in 2025 with **68 winners to his name**. He is represented by no fewer than **seven yearlings** at Auctav:

- **Lot 22 – N24 Collect Call:** "Very typical of *Goken* in his frame, with a strong shoulder and hindquarters. He looks precocious." (Mélanie Laigre, Haras de Saint Maur)
- **Lot 24 – Don't Be Cruel:** a filly out of the sister to top-class *Pornichet*.
- **Lot 28 – Oryon'K:** from the family of *Ultra* and *Modern Games*.
- **Lot 40 – N24 Invincible Sea:** first foal out of a dual winner from the influential *Mare Nostrum* family.
- **Lot 49 – Go Cassis:** own-sister to *M'Silla*, who defeated *Fréville*.
- **Lot 62 – On The Road Again:** three siblings scored this summer – *We Ride The World*, *Hunter Valley* and *We Can Do It*.
- **Lot 99 – N24 Xaarina:** a colt out of black-type *Xaarina*, already the dam of four winners including *Xaarine*, the own-sister to this lot.

Anodin also excelled with **84 winners in 2024** and already close to 50 in 2025. He is represented by four yearlings:

- **Lot 59 – N24 Mavilla**, out of a mare who scored both on the Flat and over jumps.
- **Lot 83 – Opgun Sterenn**, a half-brother to five winners including black-type *Spitzbergen*.
- **Lot 89 – Hakuma Tatizo**, out of a mare who is a sister to Gr.3 winners *Gloomy Sunday* and *Abjer*.
- **Lot 96 – N24 White Ville**, third foal of a mare whose first, *A Nos Souvenirs*, has already won three races, including at Clairefontaine this summer.

Other sires well represented include:

- **Zelzal** with *After Dawn* (Lot 3), out of the sister to *Ectot* and *Most Improved*, and *Ozark James* (Lot 23), out of the sister to *Mageva*.
- **City Light** with *Flying Flash* (Lot 2), a half-brother to black-type hurdler *Afadil*; *Oceano Bello* (Lot 33), out of a three-time winning daughter of *Orpen*; and *Star of Doha* (Lot 85), described by Jean-Paul Challet (Haras de Précolette) as "a very attractive filly with quality and strength, ready to run early."

Yoshino, a precocious prospect

Yoshino (Lot 50), by young sire **Laccario**, is out of a mare who won at two and was fourth in the Prix des Jouvenceaux et des Jouvencelles (L). She has already produced four winners, while the second and third dams also won at two. Yoshino is qualified for French and German premiums as well as the Auktionrennen series.

Niccolo Riva (Haras d'Annebault): *"All four of the mare's previous foals have run and all have won. He is a good model from a proven winning family, which is very promising."*

The other wild cards

- **Lot 11 – Intello x Atarfe (C.2024, Élevage du Moulin Hellain):** from a family with four winners including two black-type, notably *Arasin*.
- **Lot 23 – Ozark James (Zelzal x Iris James) (C.2024, Haras de Saint Maur):** first foal of the sister to Classic performer *Mageva*, from the solid family of *Linngari* and *Pyledriver*.
- **Lot 44 – Victor Ludorum x Samskara (C.2024, Haras du Vieux Bourg):** half-brother to *Gentlemanlike*, by the promising sire *Victor Ludorum*.
- **Lot 72 – Ardad x Wild Mimosa (F.2024, Haras de Fergand):** out of a distinguished family that includes *Summoner* and *The Fugue*, a filly with both racing and breeding appeal.
