Two Stallions Featured in the Auctav Breeding Sale

On Friday, 12 December at 2:00 pm, the Auctav Breeding Sale will bring together all disciplines. In the Thoroughbred section, two stallions—*Savoir Vivre* and *Robin of Navan*—headline the catalogue.

Robin of Navan

Auctav will offer the stallion **Robin of Navan** for sale on 12 December. He has been standing at **Haras de la Barbottière** in the Sarthe region since 2020.

A model of toughness and consistency, **Robin of Navan** competed at the highest level from ages 2 to 6 before beginning his stallion career in 2020, standing for **€3,000 LF** in 2025.

A **Group 1 winner at two** in the *Critérium de Saint-Cloud*, the former trainee of Harry Dunlop remained at the top throughout his career, particularly over intermediate distances. His achievements include victories in the:

- **Meilen Trophy (Gr.2)**
- **La Coupe (Gr.3)**
- **Prix de Condé (Gr.3)**

...as well as placings in the **Prix d'Ispahan (Gr.1)** and **Premio Roma (Gr.1)**.

By **American Post** out of *Cloghran*, he hails from the family of **The Wise Lady (Gr.3)**, making him closely related to **Lily's Candle** and Japanese champion **Lys Gracieux**, both Group 1 winners.

Promising Early Performances on the Track

Robin of Navan's early crops have shown versatility, winning **both on the flat and over jumps**:

- **Lily Ofthe Kingdom (F)** – 3 wins, 9 places – €47,868
- **Lady Du Saphir (F)** – 2 wins, 14 places – €32,837
- **Biak Lescreibaa (F)** – 1 win, 5 places – €19,360
- **Saint Robin (H)** – 1 win, 4 places – €25,445

These results confirm a **reliable and competitive production**, reflecting the stallion's own attributes of stamina, courage, and consistency. Robin of Navan will be presented at the **Auctav Breeding Sale on 12 December**.

Savoir Vivre

Winner of the **Grand Prix de Deauville (Gr.2)** at three, and runner-up in both the **Deutsches Derby (Gr.1)** and **Gran Premio del Jockey-Club (Gr.2)**, **Savoir Vivre** boasts an impressive race record.

A son of the top German stallion **Adlerflug**, he also carries a superb maternal pedigree through his **Monsun** dam. His close family includes none other than **Stacelita**, the six-time Group 1 winner (including the Prix de Diane and Beverley D Stakes) and elite broodmare.

A powerful, active, and highly reliable family, **Savoir Vivre**'s maternal line continues to produce performers at the highest level.

Strong Credentials as a Sire

Savoir Vivre is already standing out through notable runners, particularly among Anglo-Arabs:

- **BOOMERANG** – winner of the Grand Prix des Anglo-Arabs
- **JORAH DE LA BRUNIE** – winner of the Prix du Ministère de l’Agriculture (12.5%) at Tarbes, 3rd in the Grand Prix des Anglo-Arabs at Saint-Cloud

He has also sired winners among Thoroughbreds and AQPS.

Well-Bred Broodmares in the Catalogue

COSACHOPE (F, 2014) – In foal to Goken

A triple winner, including the **Prix du Bois (Gr.3)**. Daughter of First Chope, who produced only winners.

In foal to **Goken**, France’s leading sire by number of wins in 2025 (86 wins as of 26 November).

BADEE AH (F, 2012) – In foal to Al Hakeem

A black-type mare and dam of four winners, including **Princess Badee**, Group 3 winner. Her dam, **Space Quest**, produced only winners, all at Group level. Badee Ah is also a sister to the stallion **Kocab**.

MIDNIGHT AURORA (F, 2013) – In foal to Goliath du Berlais

⚠ Foal will be registered OC or CSAN.

A four-time winner over jumps in Great Britain.

From a strong National Hunt family: sister to Chaouia and closely related to **La Palmeraie**, Group 1 and Group 2 winner.

In foal to the popular **Goliath du Berlais**.

MAYYADAH (F, 2010) – In foal to Bubble Gift

A daughter of **Invincible Spirit**, Listed winner and Group 3-placed.

Sister to **Serisia** (Gr.3), dam of Group 1 winner **Contributer** (€751,635).

A highly active and productive family that includes Group 1 performers such as **Survie** and **King of Steel**.

In foal to the young sire **Bubble Gift**, whose first foals are on the ground.

QUIANA (F, 2009) – Barren

Dam of **Quian** (Mastercraftsman), winner of a Gr.2 and Gr.3.

Sister to **Quijano**, multiple Group 1 winner in Europe and Hong Kong and now a sire.

Also catalogued: **Queen Street (F, 2014)** – daughter of Quiana, sister to Gr.2 and Gr.3 winner Quian, **in foal to Goken**, the leading French sire by number of wins in 2025.
