Affaire Solitaire joins the Auctav Breeding Sale stallion roster

The Auctav Breeding Sale on Friday, 12 December at 2pm will feature not only Savoir Vivre and Robin of Navan, but now a third stallion added to the catalogue: Affaire Solitaire, consigned by Haras d'Annebault.

A long and productive racing career

Best known for his victory in the **Prix Exbury (Gr.3)** over the Saint-Cloud mile, Affaire Solitaire built his reputation on consistency and soundness. Racing from 2 to 6 years old over distances between 1600 and 2000 metres, he made 27 starts and finished in the first five on 22 occasions, amassing more than €350,000 in earnings. His résumé also includes a series of Listed and Group placings, confirming his reliability at Pattern level.

A pedigree of rare depth

A son of **Danehill Dancer** out of the black-type mare **Arlésienne**, Affaire Solitaire descends from one of the most reliable families in training. He is a brother to six winners, three of whom have earned black-type, including the stallion **Aizavoski**, **Andromeda Galaxy**, dam of Verstappen, and **Altamira**, dam of Akatea. The strength of this family is such that a single generation and its descendants fill an entire pedigree page.

A confirmed dual-purpose stallion

Affaire Solitaire has already demonstrated real versatility at stud, producing performers of black-type calibre both on the Flat and over Jumps. On the Flat, his daughter **Caos Calmos** captured a Listed race and finished third in the Italian Derby (Gr.2), while the filly **Nikkei** also achieved Group placings. Over obstacles, **Lady in the Lake** captured a Group 3 chase at Merano, and **Betrayal** finished third in the 4yo Championship Hurdle in 2025. His progeny share his consistency, attitude and staying qualities, making him an attractive option for breeders seeking a stallion with proven versatility.

Other Stallions in the Catalogue

Robin of Navan - Standing at Haras de la Barbottière, Robin of Navan has already established himself as a reliable stallion after a racing career marked by courage and endurance from ages 2 to 6. His victory in the **Criterium de Saint-Cloud (Gr.1)** remains a highlight, and he hails from an active family closely related to **Lily's Candle** and the Japanese champion **Lys Gracieux**. His first runners show the attributes he displayed himself: toughness, consistency and the ability to perform both on the Flat and over obstacles.

Savoir Vivre - A son of the influential **Adlerflug** and from a remarkable female line tracing to the six-time Group 1 heroine **Stacelita**, Savoir Vivre enjoyed a top-level career highlighted by his **Grand Prix de Deauville (Gr.2)** success and runner-up finish in the **Deutsches Derby (Gr.1)**. His early results at stud are promising, particularly among Anglo-Arabs, where he has sired performers such as **Boomerang** and **Jorah de la Brunie**, alongside several winning Thoroughbreds and AQPS.
