



## Auctav Arabian Summer Sale A catalogue with proven and promising performers

The first Purebred Arabian sale of the year in France takes place on 25 June on [auctav.com](https://auctav.com), with over thirty lots catalogued for the Auctav Arabian Summer Sale. This selection includes exciting prospects for the racetrack and the breeding shed alike.

### Ghaiyyath (Mister Ginoux x Clairvoyant) – 2023 colt - Consigned by Haras du Saubouas

A 2yo colt and full brother to **Sniper de Monlau**, winner of the **Arabian Triple Crown (Gr.3 PA)** and third in the **Kahayla Classic (Gr.1 PA)** at Meydan. The family also includes Group performers **Thi Qar** and **Alobayyah**. Dam **Clairvoyant** is a consistent broodmare with multiple winners to her name across Europe and the Middle East.

### Bella Al Shahania (Gazwan x Salma Al Khalediah) – 2023 filly - Consigned by Al Shahania Stud

This 2yo filly by **Gazwan** is from the productive line of **Salma Al Khalediah**, whose recent progeny continue to impress. Her 5yo brother **Samsa Al Shahania** is a winner and Group 2-placed, having never finished outside the top five. Her 4yo sister **Gaeeda Al Shahania** (by Mared Al Sahara) is also remarkably consistent, twice a winner and always in the frame in Qatar. She descends from the distinguished family of **Quesche du Paon** and **Bint El Bedia**, responsible for numerous champions.

**Arnault Leraître, Al Shahania Stud:** "She's an excellent mover and bears a strong resemblance to her brother Samsa, a respected Group performer carefully handled to reach his full potential. We are very pleased with Gazwan's first runners on the track, which adds to the promise of this filly."

### Mushra (Mushrae x Diva des Eaux) – 2023 filly - Consigned by Écurie d'Ossau

From the outstanding **Danzina** family, winner of eight races and dam of **Themis** (Emir's Sword, Gr.1 PA) and **Danzinon** (UAE President Cup, Gr.1 PA), this female line also features **Khataab** and **Al Anood**. Her dam **Diva des Eaux** has already produced **Prince d'Ossau** (by Al Tair), a winner in Qatar. Mushra is the first foal from this dam by **Mushrae**, heir to the dynasties of **Cherifa** and **Djezika**.

**Jean-Pierre Totain, Écurie d'Ossau:** "She's a magnificent filly, already approaching 1.60m at two years old. Her coat is the same deep chestnut as her sire Mushrae. Her older siblings were highly regarded but had setbacks. Now Prince d'Ossau's win in Qatar is finally shining a light on this very promising family. I trained Mushrae—he was a phenomenon—and I firmly believe his offspring will prove he's a top-class stallion."

### HK Anastasia (Af Albahar x Eyana) – 2023 filly - Consigned by Al Cem Stud

This daughter of **Af Albahar** is the final foal out of **Eyana**, by Madjani out of Mangadore. Eyana hails from a prolific family, being a full sister to **Jumuh**, a Group 2 PA winner in Toulouse, and half-sister to winners **Hareq ASF** and **Mosaab**. Her niece **Nazwa** (by Jaafer ASF) placed no fewer than 13 times in France and Qatar, including four wins. Anastasia represents the last opportunity to tap into this branch of the influential Enaya line.

**Chloé Marchandet, Al Cem Stud:** "Sired by top performer Af Albahar, Anastasia is the last daughter of Eyana, making her the final chance to secure this winning bloodline. The family has already produced multiple black-type performers."

### Mystic de Mega (Nafees x Darvina) – 2022 colt - Consigned by Olivier Trigodet

Mystic de Mega is a 3yo colt from a high-class female line. His second dam, **Danzina**, was a prolific winner with eight victories, and produced **Themis**, winner of the **Emir's Sword (Gr.1 PA)**, and **Danzinon**, who landed the **UAE President Cup (Gr.1 PA)**. The family also features **Khataab** and **Al Anood**. His sire, **Nafees**, has his first crop turning four in 2025.

**Olivier Trigodet, trainer:** "He just arrived from pre-training on June 4th. He's a lovely model with good conformation and promising presence. I'll have a clearer picture of his ability in the coming days."

#### **Mahsoub (Al Mourtajez x Al Fahda) – 2021 gelding - Consigned by Al Shaqab Racing**

A debut winner and placed in Group 2 and Group 1 company, **Mahsoub** ran in the prestigious **Al Rayyan Cup**. He is bred on a classic cross between elite sire **Al Mourtajez** and **Al Fahda**, winner of the **Qatar Arabian Trophy des Pouliches (Gr.1 PA)**. His dam line descends from **Salma**, the dam of **Al Sabaq** and **Al Nachmiya**.

**Thomas Fourcy, trainer:** "He made a winning debut and showed real quality. He was later gelded due to a testicular issue, but he's now in great condition. He'll suit international racing very well."

#### **Mghetha (Al Mouwaffak x Gherdaiya) – 2021 filly - Consigned by Al Shaqab Racing**

This 4yo filly is by **Al Mouwaffak**, a stallion in high demand, and is a full sister to the brilliant **Lwsail**. Her half-sister **Alsafnah** is a winner in Qatar. The female line traces back to the influential **Praline du Cassou**, the foundation of horses like **Parador** and **Prado**.

**Thomas Fourcy, trainer:** "Mghetha has been sound and easy to train. She's best suited to quicker ground, where her light frame and athleticism can shine. She looks made for international tracks."

#### **Apricus Forta (Abu Alemarat x Empress Bibi Forta) – 2022 colt - Consigned by Al Asayl France**

This 3yo colt comes from a powerful American family that has consistently delivered at Group 1 level. Relatives include **Royal Atheena** (16-time winner, including two Group 1s), **Royal Richest**, **Royally Bred**, and **Bellfastt**.

#### **Al Nayef (Af Albahar x Miss Boum Al Maury) – 2023 colt - Consigned by Haras du Saubouas**

By **Af Albahar** out of **Miss Boum Al Maury**, a dual winner and Listed-placed mare whose pedigree traces directly back to the blue hen **Cherifa**. Her first foal has already placed twice from as many starts this spring.

#### **Nahar (Nieshan x Kantalie de Ghazal) – 2023 colt - Consigned by Haras du Saubouas**

Out of a sister to the outstanding **Kiss de Ghazal**, this 2yo colt hails from the esteemed **Ghazal** line, which goes back to **Key du Cassou**. The Nieshan-Ghazal cross is an intriguing and rare combination on the market.

#### **Mona Lisa Dumoulin (Yazeed x Athena des Violettes) – 2022 filly - Consigned by Gaël Lemer**

A sister to **Kawai des Violettes**, a winner in both France and Qatar. This unraced 3yo descends from a family known for producing winners both on the flat and in endurance disciplines.

**Gaël Lemer, trainer:** "She came to training late and should be ready to debut towards the end of the year on the French programme. She's progressing steadily."
