A selection of very well-bred broodmares and horses in training further enriches this high-profile sale.**

### The Broodmares

#### **Shararah (Al Mouwaffak x Dormadora) – 2020 mare in foal to Al Mourtajez**

A sister to the outstanding **Dahor de Brugère**, both a champion on the track and a successful sire. Shararah is in foal for the first time, carrying to the highly sought-after **Al Mourtajez**.



#### **Alamriya (Amer x Frynch) – 2014 mare in foal to Al Mourtajez, with colt foal at foot by Al Mamun Monlau**

Out of the exceptional foundation mare **Frynch**, Alamriya is the dam of the full brother to **RB Paris Flyght**, a winner in Qatar. She is in foal for the first time to top stallion **Al Mourtajez**.

#### **Almaronah (Dormane x Macha'Allah) – 2019 mare in foal to Muraaqib, with filly foal at foot by No Risk Al Maury**

From the direct maternal family of **Al Mourtajez**. This mare by **Dormane** is out of a sister to the champion himself, and is in foal to **Muraaqib**, with a strong filly at foot by **No Risk Al Maury**.

#### **Kaltham (Al Mamun Monlau x Khzama) – 2021 mare in foal to Al Mourtajez**

In foal to the proven sire **Al Mourtajez**, source of champions like **Al Ghadeer** and **Lwsail**.

Kaltham is a sister to **Al Afreetah**, a Group 2 PA-placed winner, from a family packed with black-type performers in every generation.

**Um Graibah (Amer x Koriana) – 2013 mare in foal to Al Mourtajez, with filly foal at foot by Azadi**

Carrying to **Al Mourtajez** for the first time, and with a smart filly foal by **Azadi** at foot—a full sister to both **Mdawi** and **Um Jolag**.

**Walaa (Dahess x Kerra) – 2015 mare in foal to Azadi, with colt foal at foot by Azadi**

A **full sister to champion Lwsail**, Walaa is in foal and has a colt foal at foot, both by **Azadi**. A daughter of **Dahess**, she brings the proven success of a renowned sire of broodmares.

## Stallion Prospect

**Mwarid (Amer x Al Nachmiya) – 2016 horse in training with Thomas Fourcy**

A **six-time winner**, including a **Group 3 PA**, and multiple **Group 1 PA-placed**, **Mwarid** finished second in a Group 3 PA on his latest start. He is a **full brother to Al Haffanah** and is bred on the golden cross of **Amer x Al Nachmiya**—a true stallion prospect from a lineage rich with history and success.



## Horses in Training

**Mohtaram (Azadi x Tameemah) – 2021 colt in training with Thomas Fourcy**

By **Azadi** out of **Tameemah**, a Group 3 PA winner and Group 1 PA-placed mare. Mohtaram is a brother to **Al Tammtam** (Listed and Gr.1 PA-placed), **Bint Alarab** (dual winner in Qatar), and **Alhareth**, a regular performer.

**Darb (Al Mourtajez x Florihala) – 2021 gelding in training with Jean de Mieulle**

Unraced son of **Al Mourtajez**, out of the **full sister to Dorfa and Fadjik**. A serious prospect from a deep black-type family.

**Maarek (Manark x Al Jassasiya) – 2021 colt in training with Thomas Fourcy**

Recently **3rd in the Prix Ziyadd** on 11 June at Bordeaux, showing an eye-catching turn of foot in the final straight.

**Shemlwol (Al Mouwaffak x Majida) – 2020 gelding in training with Jean de Mieulle**

A two-time winner and **Group 2 PA-placed at 3**, **Shemlwol** returned this season after a **19-month break** and secured a respectable fifth place on comeback.

**Mghetha (Al Mouwaffak x Gherdaiya) – 2021 filly - in training with Thomas Fourcy**

A 4yo filly by **Al Mouwaffak** and a full sister to **Group performer Lwsail**. Her sister **Alsafnah** is a winner in Qatar. Her third dam is the influential **Praline du Cassou**, dam of **Parador, Prado**, and others.

**Mahsoub (Al Mourtajez x Al Fahda) – 2021 gelding - in training with Thomas Fourcy**

By **Al Mourtajez** out of **Al Fahda**, winner of the **Qatar Arabian Trophy des Pouliches (Gr.1 PA)**. The damline traces back to **Salma**, the grand producer of **Al Sabaq** and **Al Nachmiya**.
