



HUNTER VALLEY SALE Potential, promise and experience among the horses in training

The Hunter Valley Sale on Wednesday, 8 October, features 18 horses in training, ranging from unraced two-year-olds and highly promising debutants to proven and seasoned performers.

The 2-year-olds

- **56 Nun Warrior (Village Mystic x Honesty Love) F 2023 :** A sister to **Marvel**, a promising youngster who has already picked up two third places from his first three starts, she is showing considerable potential in training. Equally at ease left- or right-handed, she has plenty of natural speed. From an outstanding family featuring a 3x3 inbreeding to **Guilty Of Love**, this well-bred filly is the granddaughter of a sister to **LOVE YOU**. An exceptional pedigree page.
- **58 Nina de Vandel (Impressionist x Glama de Vandel) F 2023 :** Qualified this summer at Caen in **1'19''6** with minimal preparation, she is by a highly promising stallion with his first runners this season. Strongly made, very much in the mould of her sire, she shows an excellent turn of foot. A serious, professional type with natural class, she is ready to debut in the coming weeks and should give quick satisfaction to new connections.
- **60 Nyx de la Haie (Impressionist x Hemera du Goutier) F 2023 :** Qualified in great style at Caen, this attractive filly had little luck in her first two starts. Most recently, she finished 4th at Vincennes in a sharp **1'16"4**, proving that she has the quality to perform well in the Paris region.
- **62 Nacre Galaxy (Charly du Noyer x Golden Galaxy) F 2023 :** Qualified at Caen in **1'18''6**, she made a winning debut in confident style. Carefully handled with the winter campaign in mind, she is among the yard's top hopes among the fillies. She also boasts an attractive pedigree for future breeding.
- **66 Nova de Celland (Impressionist x Topaze de Tillard) F 2023 :** A sister to **Igrec de Celland**, winner of the 2024 GNT, she is regarded as one of the yard's best fillies for the future. Recently placed at Vincennes, she has been patiently campaigned and has proven she has the potential to compete with the best of her generation. A rare pedigree to find on the open market.
- 67 Nice To Me (Hohneck x Belong To Me) F 2023 : Qualified with ease in 1'18"7 at Caen last month, this daughter of the very fashionable Hohneck continues to make progress. Ready to debut soon, she should make her presence felt straight away.
- **68 Nemaki (Impressionist x Temaki Wise As) F 2023 :** By **Impressionist**, who has produced a very high percentage of qualifiers, out of a mare by **Muscle Hill** from a strong Italian family. Qualified in **1'17"4** with little work, she has improved steadily and is ready to make her debut. Possesses plenty of speed and has shown she can produce a strong finish when given a lead.
- **70 Nereida (Django Riff x Decima) F 2023 :** Qualified in excellent style, she finished a very good second on debut at Enghien behind **Normandie Niemen** in July. She then scored impressively at Vincennes last month, clocking **1'14"9**, and is being prepared for a Group-level campaign this winter. Carefully nurtured from the outset, she continues to progress and is already regarded as one of the best of her generation.





- 71 Novak (Impressionist x Conquête à Deux) M 2023 : Already four winners in this family, including Key Biscayne (a Vincennes winner) and Less Time. Out of a 3/4-sister to the Classic performer A Nous Deux, this colt descends from the outstanding Nina Madrik line. Well-made with scope, he has all the qualities to become a high-class performer.
- 73 Nahama (Express Jet x Tequila Cocktail) F 2023: Out of the Classic mare
 Tequila Cocktail, this two-year-old is a sister to three winners. A pedigree steeped in class, offering both precocity and depth.

Three-Year-Olds and Older Horses

- **57 Lovanitto (Express Jet x Rivanetta) C 2021 :** Winner of 3 races with a further three runner-up placings from just eight starts, this son of **EXPRESS JET** is not only highly consistent but also looks to have plenty more to come. With just under €40,000 in earnings, he remains well-handicapped and has always been handled with patience by his connections.
- **59 King Stallion (Ready Cash x Cara Mia Wood) G 2020 :** By **Ready Cash** and out of a sister to **FOLLOW YOU**, he has shown his ability under saddle with two victories at Vincennes. Runner-up there this summer, he has recently been alternating between harness and mounted races. With only €70,000 in earnings so far, he looks poised for a strong campaign this winter, having already proven his quality.
- 63 Lucky Boy (Face Time Bourbon x Netchka d'Orgères) C 2021: A half-brother to Village Mystic by Face Time Bourbon, this colt is still ahead of the handicapper. Twice a winner already this season, he joined his current yard only recently and is expected to find some excellent opportunities during the winter. A horse of real potential.
- 64 Montana Wood (Orlando Vici x Amie Love) C 2022: By Orlando Vici and out of a sister to champion Love You, he heads to the ring with an engagement in the Saint-Léger des Trotteurs (Gr.1) at Caen on 11 October. Always highly regarded, he has really found his stride under saddle and looks set for a strong winter. From an outstanding family, he also boasts a stallion's pedigree.
- 65 Key Biscayne (Face Time Bourbon x Conquête à Deux) G 2020 : With a record of 1'12"1, he has scored under saddle at Vincennes and collected numerous placings. Very consistent, he has been effective in both codes and impressed again this summer on the Côte d'Azur.
- **69 Leader du Pommeau (Ready Cash x Une Lady de Nappes) C 2021 :** A full brother to the stallion **Impressionist**, he carries a truly attractive pedigree. A consistent colt, he has shown form both at Vincennes and on the Côte d'Azur, where he picked up several placings this summer. With just under €60,000 in earnings, there is a bright programme ahead of him.
- **72 Iron Jet (Charly du Noyer x Amazone Jet) G 2018 :** Well-known on the French circuit, **IRON JET** has scored multiple victories in the provinces and in the Paris region. A tough and genuine type, he has over €220,000 in earnings and is now on the verge of stallion approval. Proven on turf and sand alike, he has done it all and never fails to deliver.
