



Hunter Valley Sale

Broodmares with pedigrees of the highest calibre

Offered in foal, the broodmares from the Hunter Valley consignment at the sale on Wednesday, 8 October, carry both depth of pedigree and proven production.

Alesia d'Atout – in foal to Kobayashi

A Classic mare and triple Group 2 winner, this daughter of Défi d'Aunou has produced four qualified runners who have all earned prize-money, headed by Hold Majyc (€92,780), a son of Bold Eagle. From the family of Elite d'Atout, she is in foal to the imposing Kobayashi, expected to add size and scope to her produce.

Aventura – in foal to Light My Fire

Seven winners in her immediate family, four of them with over €100,000 in earnings. Her best performer to date is Jalousie Maza (Charly du Noyer), a winner of €95,000. Out of a strong maternal line descending from Bahama, she is also dam of G3 winner Karlita. She is in foal to Light My Fire, the own-brother to Bold Eagle, a cross (Ready Cash, Love You, Goetmals Wood) that has already proven highly effective.

Canterbury – in foal to King Opera

From the maternal line of Mambo King, this daughter of Rombaldi has already produced two winners. From the Natacha du Buisson family, she has been crossed with King Opera to create valuable inbreeding to No Limit Jet.

Cara Mia Wood – in foal to Ksar

A blue-blooded mare, by Cocktail Jet out of Mara Bourbon. She is in foal to another Dubois-bred, the young stallion Ksar (by Follow You), whose first foals are on the ground in 2025. This mating produces inbreeding 2x3 to the great Mara Bourbon. Cara Mia Wood has already produced numerous tough and effective runners.

Cevennes – in foal to Kobayashi

Unraced herself, this sister to Hyper Fast (€204,030) is dam of two winners, including Kong du Dalm (Feeling Cash), a 1'09"9 performer in Sweden where he has earned more than 1.5 million SEK (€143,000). She produced a superb filly this year and is from the direct line of Kidea, and thus Ready Cash. She returns in foal to Kobayashi.

Comme Une Etoile – in foal to Krack Time Atout

Sister to Jet Set Bond and Into The Mystic, she has already produced two winners including Luminous Star, recently fifth at Vincennes. She is carrying to Krack Time Atout, by whom she produced a stunning filly in 2025. A mare with both pedigree depth and proven production – a true broodmare prospect.

Conquête à Deux – in foal to Light My Fire

Sister to A Nous Deux, she has proven highly consistent at stud with four qualified and winning progeny, three of whom have already earned over €80,000. A big-framed mare with an outstanding page, she is in foal to Light My Fire. This mating has already worked well, having produced the Bold Eagle filly *In Between Us*. A direct descendant of Nina Madrik, this mare does nothing but produce racehorses.

Dame Josselyn



A sister to Guido Josselyn and Kika Josselyn. Her best runner, Ika Josselyn, is the winner of eleven races. Her "O" colt by Impressionist has shown plenty of promise in early training.

Doceanide

A sister to Hatchet Man and Epatante, she never raced herself but has already produced three winners from four foals, led by Italienne (€125,000, 1'12"3). From the immediate family of Ready Cash, she is a lovely mare who crosses ideally with Love You. Her "N", Nocéanide (by Impressionist, trained by Philippe Allaire), recently qualified in 1'17"8.

Edifie La – in foal to Kamehameha

This well-stamped daughter of Ready Cash is the dam of Kuzco (€70,000+). Her yearling, Open Sky (by Doberman), has been retained and is showing promise in pre-training.

Famille Royale – in foal to Kobayashi

A winner at Vincennes, she is a daughter of Village Mystic and a sister to Texas Style, Combattante, Douce Aventure and Hambo. Her first two foals are both winners, including *Killer Queen* (Face Time Bourbon), G2 placed and the holder of a 1'12"6 record. *Orly Queen* (Charly du Noyer), currently in training at Hunter Valley, is also very promising. Noted for strongly stamping her stock with good temperament, she is in foal to Kobayashi. The cross with sons of Face Time Bourbon has already delivered results in this family through Killer Queen.

Fedorova d'Orgères – in foal to Krack Time Atout

From the famed Netchka d'Orgères line, she is a broodmare with scope and substance. In foal to a stallion in whom the stud has great confidence, Krack Time Atout.

Fortuna Jet – in foal to Kobayashi

Winner herself and a sister to Quaker Jet, her first two foals have both earned prize-money, including Kitty Call, a Vincennes winner. From the Delmonica Jet maternal line. She is in foal to Kobayashi, introducing a new line as she has never previously been crossed with Face Time Bourbon blood.

Geantissime – in foal to Krack Time Atout

Own-sister to Hidden Texas (€206,010), she was a two-time winner on the track and her first foal has already qualified with ease. From the prestigious "New York/Nesmile" family, her 2024 Kamehameha filly is outstanding. She is now in foal to Krack Time Atout, whose early stock are highly promising.

Harmony Jet – in foal to Django Riff

Sister to young sire Kamehameha, this young mare has not yet had progeny run.

Holly Go Lightly (DK) – in foal to Krack Time Atout

This striking Danish mare, a daughter of Varenne, showed blistering speed on the track. In foal with her first produce, she represents a proven cross as Krack Time Atout has nicked well with foreign mares.

Jain de Celand – in foal to Kobayashi

Sister to Grand National du Trot hero Igréc de Celand, she enjoyed a successful racing career in the southwest before producing a fine first foal in 2025, a filly by Instrumentaliste. From the same maternal line as Idao de Tillard, she is now in foal to Kobayashi.

Lorica – in foal to Kobayashi

A short but fruitful racing career with two wins, including at Enghien, and now carrying her first foal. By Face Time Bourbon's son Kobayashi, the mating adds both size and class to her strong maternal line descending from the great Slave.

Mandragore – in foal to King Opera



By Love You, she qualified in a smart 1'17''2 but was unable to confirm her potential on the track. Both her brothers earned over €50,000. Carrying her first foal, she has been paired with King Opera, creating an exciting mix with Love You blood.

Maya Bee – in foal to Express Jet

A Vincennes winner and three-quarter sister to Jagerbomb (€116,860), she is carrying her first foal, by Express Jet. From the Encombevaineuse family, a pedigree steeped in breeding excellence.

Miami Dream

Recently retired to stud, this winning daughter of Follow You is out of Giulietta Jet and closely related to Isla Jet. A well-bred mare with a physique stamped by her sire.

Miss du Bief – in foal to Express Jet

Unraced but a full-sister to stallion Invincible Cash (Ready Cash). She is carrying her first foal, by Express Jet.

Natsuki (not in foal)

A daughter of Impressionist out of the own-sister to Hidden Texas, she is presented straight from training.

Nice Mom – in foal to Krack Time Atout

An Italian-bred daughter of Varenne, she is a young mare and a sister to the good Mystic Mom (€117,336). From the family of Traders. Notably, the first Krack Time Atout foals out of foreign mares have been very attractive.

Ruby Hill (GER) – in foal to Express Jet

A 2020-born Ready Cash mare from a maternal line successful in Sweden and the USA. Her 2024 colt, *Neutron Bomb*, is already showing promise in pre-training. A valuable recruit for international breeders.

Temaki Wise As (IT) – in foal to Krack Time Atout

By Muscle Hill, she has already produced four winners including Daytona Wise As. From a long line of top-class US and Scandinavian performers. She produced a superb Krack Time Atout foal this year, prompting a return visit. Her two-year-old by Impressionist qualified impressively in 1'17''4. Her foals are well-marked and carry a strong "American" stamp.

Trackmania – in foal to Krack Time Atout

A five-time winner at Vincennes, she has produced five winners, three of whom have earned over €100,000: Dazzle Jet (1'11''8), Krackmania (1'11''6) and Jetpack (1'12''1). From the family of Goetmals Wood, she has the scope and depth to continue producing high-level runners.
