FLORIHALA - M 2014

HARAS DE THOUARS

On the track, Florihala (by Dormane) finished in the top five in six of her nine starts, including two podium finishes. She is the dam of Kimfalah (Akim de Ducor), who recorded 11 podium finishes including two wins in Qatar from 13 starts; Melk (Munjiz), who achieved seven podium finishes including a victory in Doha; and Fhatima (Akim de Ducor), who was also placed in Qatar.

Florihala is a full sister to the outstanding Dorfa, winner of 10 races including the Emir's Sword, and to Frasquitha, dam of Ahzar (Munjiz), a Group 3 winner and Group 1 performer.

RAHEEL ASF - M 2007

AL SHAHANIA STUD

She is a full sister to the champion racehorse and sire Gazwan, and comes from an exceptionally successful family that includes eight other winners. She has already produced winners herself: Suka'ar (Burning Sand), a winner in Qatar, as well as Kab Gazal (No Risk Al Maury) and Zazoom (Mahabb), both also successful there. It is an outstanding maternal line.





SOLITUDE AL MAURY - M 2021

HARAS DU MAURY

Solitude Al Maury (Nieshan) is offered in foal with her first offspring by the young stallion Ebraz. This strong maternal line traces back to Sivit Al Maury, Sylvine Al Maury, Sunbeam Al Maury, and more recently Sirene Al Maury, winner of the 2024 French Arabian Breeders' Challenge Sprint.

Renée Koch, breeder: "It's a very strong family that also includes the promising Sienne Al Maury, who won by seven lengths at Castera Verduzan. Solitude Al Maury is a mare with great scope and presence. She had a really beautiful conformation, which is why I sent her straight to stud. I have a great appreciation for the progeny of Ebraz, whose offspring are truly exceptional, which led me to choose this mating. She is a 100% French-bred mare, free of Amer blood. I have great faith in her potential, and she is extremely easy to match in terms of pedigree."

MANARAH - M 2021

ROYAL CAVALRY OF OMAN

A winner over 2000 metres and twice Group 3 placed, this daughter of Majd Al Arab is a half-sister to Worood, a Group 3 winner and runner-up in the Qatar Arabian Trophy des Pouliches (Gr.1), who has already proven an excellent producer. A genuine breeding prospect.

Élisabeth Bernard, trainer: "Manarah is a terrific competitor, whatever the ground — light or heavy, sand or turf. She's a beautifully made mare, very brave and Group placed. She is an ideal breeding prospect."

N24 LADY HAHHA - C 2024

HARAS DU SAUBOUAS

Fils du recherché Al Mourtajez, ce yearling est issue de Lady Haha, lauréate de 5 courses aux USA dont un Groupe 2. Elle s'est également placée au niveau Groupe 1.

KATYUSHA AT - F 2022

ARABIAN HORSES RACES

This filly by the versatile Al Mamun Monlau hails from one of the most prestigious dam lines in Arabian racing — that of Nerva du Cassou. This exceptional family has produced Group 1 PA winners such as Al Fatih, Rasheeqah, and Samaa, as well as leading sires Nizam, Dahess, and Parador, among others.

'Katyusha is a magnificent filly, both elegant and well-balanced. Sound and correct, she is offered as a racing and breeding prospect. MAJEEBAH MM - F 2022

MARION MOTTOUL

A winner on debut, this daughter of Al Mourtajez hails from a strong maternal line featuring multiple winners under her second dam, including Altobello (Kerbella), a four-time winner highlighted by a Group 2 success at Newbury, as well as Altyko du Cayrou (Akbar) and Altello (Kerbella). Her dam's sire Munjiz combines particularly well with Al Mourtajez, a cross that has already proven highly successful with horses such as HM Alchaine.

Thomas Fourcy, trainer: "Majeebah MM is a filly I have always held in high regard. She won a modest race but has the ability to compete at Group level, which is why I've run her in stronger company. She has enough speed for shorter distances but should also stay further in time. She's a lovely, powerful filly — genuine, talented, and full of potential."

LISAILI - F 2022

TR. FRANÇOIS ROHAUT

This three-year-old filly by TH Richie is out of RB Lam Tara, winner in Abu Dhabi of a leg of the Triple Crown over 1,600 metres, as well as two Group 3 races there, including the Al Ruwais Stakes (Gr.3). She hails from an outstanding American maternal line. There are already two winners in this immediate family, including RB Lock and Toad, fourth in a Group 3.

François Rohaut, trainer: "Lisaili is a sound filly with a good physique and easy to train. She still has more potential to unfold. She has both the build and the pedigree to make a good competitor. She handles the sand well, as her pedigree suggests, but she does not appreciate heavy ground."

AL TAOUY - C 2022

TR. CHARLES GOURDAIN

This unraced three-year-old boasts an exceptional pedigree as a son of Al Mourtajez and Win Taouy, dam of champions such as Djet Taouy, Ameretto, Ramiz Al Aziz, and many other top performers.

Charles Gourdain, trainer: "He's a good-looking, very athletic colt with a willing attitude and an excellent temperament. He's cantering every day and will be ready to run early in the year. He's a 2000-metre type, quite versatile when it comes to surface."
