

Indie, a Niarchos Family Filly for the Auctav Arabian Autumn Sale

Flaxman Stables will offer the filly Indie in the training section of the Auctav Arabian Autumn Sale catalogue on November 6th. A daughter of Gazwan, the 3-year-old is a dual purpose prospect for racing and breeding.

The Arabian Niarchos bloodline

Indie is from the first crop of the stallion Gazwan. Trained by Philippe Sogorb, the filly is still quite green with only two starts. "At the beginning of the season, her trainer was very fond of the filly and had high hopes," explains Alan Cooper, racing manager of Flaxman Stables. "This quality in training has not yet translated into a racecourse victory but she is still only a 3-year-old. Her future owner can either continue her racing career or turn to breeding given her magnificent pedigree."

On the dam side, she is from the very solid Flaxman Stables Arabian family, the current denomination of the families created long ago by the Niarchos family. The second dam, Bhutan, is a winner of three races and has produced very good winners, notably Tandor (Dormane), Group 1 placed, and Cobalto, also Group 1 placed, or Pegasus, who became a stallion after a fine career in France and Russia. This family has won in France, Russia, the USA, Qatar, and Morocco.
