



Friday, April 25th - Auctav April Online Sale Group 1 siblings and Promising Prospects

Auctav's upcoming 100% online sale on Friday, April 25, features a select catalogue of young horses and horses in training, including siblings to Group 1 winners and promising unraced prospects.

Lot 1 – Onyx du Breuil – Colt 2024 – Haras du Breuil

Brother to Group winner Ebene du Breuil (€196,000 in earnings). His dam, Paola Pierji, boasts a distinguished French pedigree featuring Cadoudal, Don Pasquini, and the highly successful sire Polarix. An excellent mover, this colt offers a rare opportunity to acquire a member of a highly successful French National Hunt family.

Lot 2 – Galactika – Filly 2022 – Trained by Céline Hérisson de Beauvoir

This daughter of Galiway is out of the sister to dual Group 1 winner Odeliz and black-type performer Pamplemousse. A robust female line, with Galactika's sister already a three-time winner.

Lot 3 – Orfeo – Gelding 2021 – Trained by Nicolas Caullery

A son of Le Havre, Orfeo has won over 1900 meters on the Deauville all-weather track. He is a full brother to black-type performer Atakama, multiple Listed-placed, and a half-brother to Bran (by Muhaarar), a Group 2 and Group 3 winner in the USA.

Lot 4B – Koutouzov – Gelding 2020 – Trained by Mickaël Seror

A staying type, still a maiden, with a physique suited for steeplechasing. He is a full brother to Irundo, who finished in the money in 17 of his 23 starts over hurdles, steeplechase (including a win at Auteuil), and cross-country. His siblings are late bloomers but all are winners. A well-built Karaktar offspring who excels on soft ground and over extended distances.

Lot 5 – Nikita de Ciergues – Filly 2023 – Haras des Châtaigniers

A two-year-old by the emerging sire Prince Gibraltar. She is a sister to Folsom Prison, Group-placed at Auteuil, and Inédit de Ciergues, also Group-placed at Auteuil. The dam has produced nearly exclusively successful racehorses. This beautifully moving, well-broken filly is tailored for French racing and could be the Group winner in the family.

Lot 6 – Say Magic – Filly 2023 – Haras de Say

By Magic Dream, a sought-after son of top sire Saint des Saints. Say Magic's dam has produced multiple winners. A good mover with excellent locomotion, she hails from the direct maternal line of Achour and El Fabiolo. A promising racing prospect with breeding potential, this well-sized filly offers versatility for future matings.

Lot 7 – Litleangel Duseuil – Filly 2021 – Trained by Mickaël Seror

After proving her worth on the flat with a win at Fontainebleau and a strong second at Saint-Cloud, Litleangel Duseuil made a commanding hurdle debut at Fontainebleau,

winning by 13 lengths. From the Boudot family line, known for producing winners across generations. Her sire, American Devil, consistently appears in the pedigrees of Auteuil winners.

Lot 8 – Miror – Gelding 2022 – Écurie de la Villeneuve

Miror is a son of Bande, a sire whose early progeny are attracting attention, including Liam Mera Kai, Labellevie, Color Ritano, and Queen Sister. This gelding is broken and ready to race. Out of a Saint des Saints mare, his close family includes the successful Lucky Nonantais, also by Bande. A large-framed individual built for competition.

Lot 9 – Devil's Marble – Filly 2022 – Haras des Châtaigniers

This Territories filly is **a sister to recent Group 1 winner Golden Ace**. Prepared for breeze-up sales, she is ready to start over jumps with future breeding prospects in mind. She possesses significant class and excellent movement. A rare opportunity to acquire a sister to a 2025 Cheltenham Festival Group 1 winner.

Xavier Brelaud, breeder: *"From her breeze-up experience, she has retained an impressive stride cadence under effort. She is improving daily, developing her withers, and we can see she will continue to grow."*



Lot 10 – Nombre Impaire – Colt 2023 – Haras de Peyre

A brother to Impaire et Passe, a nine-time Group 1 winner, most recently victorious at Aintree less than a month ago. Sired by Imperial Monarch, who has limited progeny but a high success rate. His siblings include Joliepoule, a two-time winner from three starts at four, and L'instant, a winner currently in training with Erwann Grall. A near replica of his illustrious brother, sharing the same movement, making Nombre Impaire an exceptionally rare offering.

Pascale Papon, breeder: *"He is like a younger twin of Impaire et Passe. The dam has had only two colts, both markedly different from the fillies and nearly identical to each*

other. Just watching him walk will captivate you. His three-year-old sister, trained by Elizabeth Allaire, is already highly regarded."



Lot 11 – Aucoeurdelanuit – Gelding 2020 – Trained by Maurizio Guarnieri

Winner in March over 1400 meters (7f) on the Chantilly all-weather track and previously in December 2024. This experienced five-year-old has delivered his best performances over distances ranging from 1400 to 1600 meters at Chantilly. Official French rating: 35.5.

Lot 11B – Your My Heart – Colt 2023 – Écurie Edouard Monfort

An unraced two-year-old colt from a strong maternal line. His dam is a winner and belongs to a family of nine winners, including five black-type performers both on the flat and over jumps. Notable relatives include Hurricane Harvey, a Grade 2-winning chaser, and Never Be Enough, a successful flat runner in the USA. A well-bred and versatile prospect.

Lot 12 – Lady Chatterley – Filly 2021 – Trained by Philippe Decouz

A four-year-old by Saxon Warrior, son of Deep Impact, out of a mare from the Aga Khan 'V' family. Trained by Philippe Decouz, she is a stayer who won over 2200 metres and has placed over longer trips. A fine cross between Japanese and French bloodlines.

Lot 13 – Leo Wood – Gelding 2021 AQPS – Trained by N. George & A. Zetterholm

A brother to Franco de Port, Grade 1 winner in Ireland and third in the Grand Steeple-Chase de Paris. This French Chaser by Cokoriko made a promising debut over hurdles at Compiègne, finishing third. A very bright prospect for National Hunt.

Amanda Zetterholm, trainer: "He's a horse who's still improving. A true steeplechaser who reminds me a lot of his brother. He's very easy to handle and has the same great attitude you see in Cokoriko progeny. We planned to give him another run this spring to mature further before saving him for the autumn campaign. He's got a great turn of foot. With a few more strides at Compiègne, he could have won."



Lot 13B – Macshadow des Crai – Gelding 2022 AQPS – Trained by Mickaël Seror

This gelding by the popular sire Jeu St Eloi made a solid debut with a third-place finish on the flat at Moulins in a competitive field. His dam comes from a consistent family and is a sister to black-type performer Achille, a winner in both France and Britain over flat and jumps.

Lot 14 – Aquilae – Filly 2021 – Haras du Bocage

A four-year-old out of training, she won on the flat at three over 2400 metres. She is from the maternal family of Prix Marcel Boussac (Gr.1) winner Proportional, who is a full sister to her dam. This same family also produced Hong Kong superstar Romantic Warrior. Her immediate siblings include three other winners.

Lot 15 – Marthine – Filly 2021 – Ellart Racing

Out of training, Marthine hails from a family of nine racehorses, all of whom earned prize money. Among them are five winners, including three black-type jumpers: My Kalissy, My Kalores, and El Camila. A filly with solid credentials and depth in the pedigree.
