

AUCTAV MAY SALE A yearling from the Blue Rose Cen family and a sister to Osmose join Niarchos-bred Ezo Fuji

The Auctav May Sale, held 100% online, will take place on Tuesday 27 May at 6pm on auctav.com. A yearling from the family of Classic winner Blue Rose Cen, a sister to Group 3 winner Osmose, and Ezo Fuji—a 3-year-old Niarchos-bred filly out of the sister to both Bago and Maxios—are the latest additions to a catalogue combining race-ready potential with top-level pedigrees.

Lot 7 – A Yearling Colt from the Family of Blue Rose Cen

Offered by UK-based Sisters Grim Bloodstock, this bay yearling is by top-class sprinter-miler **Mohaather**, sire of three black-type performers in his first crop.

A well-balanced and athletic individual, with size, scope and a good temperament, he is maturing into an eye-catching prospect. Carefully handled and produced, he is easy in every way, vice-free, and sells with a clean vet report. He is only for sale as the breeder retains fillies.

His dam Cesca is a sister to blacktype Queen Blossom, dam of the classic and multi Group 1 winner Blue Rose Cen.



Lot 9 – N23 Meiseika – Sister to Paris Style & Osmose

This 2-year-old filly boasts an international pedigree. By **Sea The Moon**, a stallion with Gr.1 winners across Europe and Australia, and out of **Meiseika**, dam of two black-type fillies: **Paris Style** (stakes performer in the US) and **Osmose**, 4th in the Gr.3 Prix Imprudence, then Gr.3 winner in Australia.

The pedigree is steeped in US class: the second dam is **Unrivaled Belle**, Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic heroine, making Meiseika a half-sister to **champion Unique Bella**.

Arnault Leraître, Al Shahania Stud: "She underwent knee surgery this winter, which delayed her prep. She's been in pre-training with Philippe Prévost Baratte, who found her focused and professional. She has great action and a lovely way of going.

Lot 4 – Ezo Fuji, from the Family of Bago and Maxios

A 3-year-old filly by **Lope de Vega** bred by Flaxman Stables, **Ezo Fuji** is offered out of training after showing promise over 2000m. Her dam, **Malicieuse** (by Galileo), hails from the elite Niarchos maternal lineage of **Bago** (Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner) and **Maxios** (Gr.1 Prix

d'Ispahan and Prix du Moulin). A rare opportunity to acquire a filly bred on proven Group 1producing genetics.



Lot 8 – Galigera, a True Haras de Colleville Product

A daughter of **Galiway**, Galigera is a winner over 2500 metres with more than €50,000 in earnings. Out of a broodmare bred from two key names in Guy Pariente's colours – **Kendargent** and **Pagera** (Gr.3 winner & Gr.1-placed) – Galigera is the first foal from a mare whose siblings include **nine winners**, four of them black-type.

Other Notable Lots:

Lot 2 – Classic Bloodlines from Siyouni

Presented by Al Shahania Stud, this **Siyouni** filly is a full sister to **Bomberg**, from the family of **Pelligrina** (Prix de Royaumont) and **Pearly Shells** (Prix Vermeille). A highly valuable female line with strong commercial and breeding appeal.

Lot 3 - Bondini, Ready-to-Run and Consistent

By **Advertise**, sire of Gr. winners, **Bondini** has three placings at 3 years old and holds a mark of 25.5. A straightforward, kind-natured filly ideal for middle-distance regional campaigns (2000–2400m). Race-ready.

Lots 1 & 6 – Venus and Her Daughters, a Well-Bred Trio from Haras de Gouffern

Haras de Gouffern offers a consistent trio from a high-class female line.

- Lot 1 is a yearling filly by Golden Horde, whose first runners are already catching the eye—including Listed winner **Rabbit's Foot** and promising winner **Alem**.
- Lot 6 is Venus, a daughter of Golden Horn, presented with a filly foal at foot by Angel Bleu, the dual Gr.1 winner at two.
 The dam line includes black-type performers such as Akemi, Hitra, and Les Hogues, making this a strong maternal family across generations.

Lot 5 – Kekoa, Ready for a Busy Summer Trotting Programme

With over €40,000 in earnings and a record of 1'12, **Kekoa** is a tough, consistent campaigner. By **Royal Dream**, he is out of **Ola Maria**, a five-time winner and full sister to semi-classic sire **Rodrigo Jet**. Described as more effective going right-handed, he holds multiple entries post-sale—including apprentice races at Caen, Angers, and Reims.

Pierre-Edouard Mary, trainer: "He's sound, has never had a setback, and I believe he could make a solid switch to monté in the future."
